**Please note that the following items:**

No seating or shelter is provided in the concert arena. Gazebos and tented structures are not permitted. Under 18's need to be accompanied by an adult. Dogs/pets are not permitted onto the concert arena except for assistance dogs. No picnic, drinks, glass or plastic bottles, barbecues, naked flames, fireworks, sparkers or lawn candles will be permitted on the site. The use of recording equipment is not permitted. You are advised to wear suitable footwear and clothing; this concert will take place even in wet weather condition. Please bring a torch as the concert will finish in darkness. The concert will go ahead in inclement weather. A first aid point will be on site, located near the Conservatory. Toilets are located within the concert arena, which will include a disabled facility. Toilets in the Conservatory will be closed for public use. The suggested meeting point outside of the concert arena is the Stables Courtyard, and inside the arena is the First Aid point near to the Conservatory. The Merlin Annual Pass, Warwick Castle Annual Pass, promotional vouchers and complimentary tickets for the Warwick Castle visitor attraction do not allow access to this event. You are not permitted to bring your own alcohol, bars will be available on site, and we do ask that you drink responsibly.
